RCO Dispensers and Probe Tool

Real Problems:

Gophers and Moles are some of the most destructive and annoying rodent pests. These burrowing pests vary in length from 6" - 12" long and work year-round to gather vegetation (gophers) and insects and worms (moles) for nourishment. Their tunneling is necessary for safety, food gathering, and raising their offspring. The crescent shaped mounding (gophers) and conical mounding (moles) and their massive tunneling can cause problems in many places quite rapidly. Our RCO handheld lightweight tools can be effective in minimizing the total hours spent on this type of project. This low impact bait placement aids in reducing bait shyness responses created by major disruptions in the tunnel system by shoveling to locate and place the traps and/or gases.

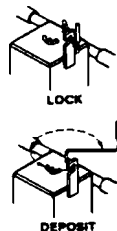
Real Options:

Introducing small amounts of grain or pelleted baits into the rodent tunnel systems in several locations with minimum of disturbance with RCO Bait Dispensers and our "RCO TUT" (tunnel unit tool) are real time savers and quite effective. Hand-set baiting or even trapping are also professionally viable but require more work and they can create a more threatened reaction by the gopher. Gassing is often ineffective because of soil moisture conditions and tunnel systems can be quite complex. Sonic devices offer little, according to scientific studies. Flooding is still operational yet and marginal and exclusion is really spendy.



Real Answers:

Our RCO hand held bait dispensers are convenient and economical to use. The RCO bait can be placed into the tunnel systems with minimal hassle to the pest's semi-closed environment. The RCO Gopher Probe Gun (8 oz. bait reservoir) or Contractor Series (16 oz. bait reservoir) are designed for grain baits for gophers. The new BIG BORE Dispenser is designed for pelleted or grain bait placement. RCO Mole Patrol needs the BIG BORE unit. All three dispensers allow for easy refilling of the bait reservoir that is mounted at the handle height. A mere twist of the crank arm releases the bait to travel down the shaft into the below ground tunnel system you have located. Lightly cap hole opening with a marker card, sod, or a clod of earth, and move on. Our new Tunnel Unit Tool, TUT, compliments all three bait dispensers which are often used incorrectly to locate tunnels in really hard pan soils. This causes excessive wear on the dispensers and contributes to poor results.

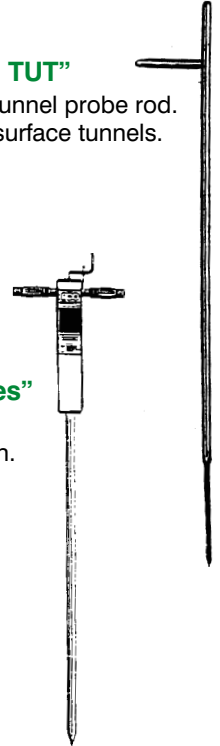


"BIG BORE"

Bait Stations

RCO IN & OUT Rodent Bait Station

For both Rats and Ground Squirrels. Heavy duty design for semi-permanent or long term usage. Portage holes allow for certain target animals and limits access to others. Can hold up to ten pounds of bait. Easy refilling chamber with child resistant lid. Great for use in field and around assets that have typical attractions to rodents, such as: stored crops, equipment, and permanent structures. Unit can be attached to secure fixture for increased safety. Place within typical range of target species.



RCO IN & OUT Rat/Mouse Bait Station

Heavy duty, extended use bait station with smaller Portage holes than the In & Out Rodent Bait Station. Reduce occurrence of accidental poisonings to children, pets & wildlife. Place around and inside buildings, stored products, vehicles, etc. Protect from rodent damage year round.
